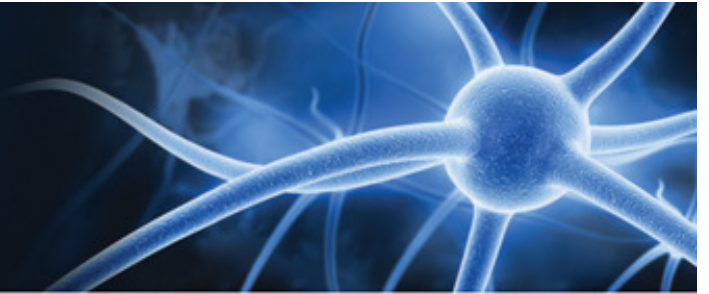

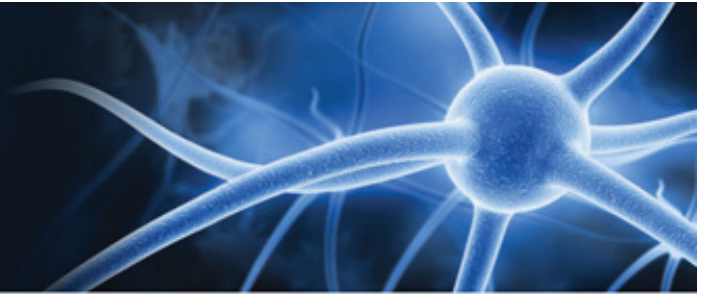
## ANA Mission
