NOW ACCEPTING LATE BREAKING POSTER ABSTRACTS FOR ANA2024

The American Neurological Association's (ANA) 149th Annual Meeting will feature peer-reviewed abstracts during the poster session at ANA2024 from September 14 -17, 2024, in Orlando. Late breaking abstracts demonstrate ongoing clinical or basic research that is new and of sufficient scientific importance to merit expedited presentation and publication. Submit your late-breaking poster abstract and present your research to academic neurologists and neuroscientists from around the world and across many subspecialties. Presenting authors can reference their poster presentation on their CV.

Requirements:

- Key aspects of the research must have been conducted after March 22, 2024.
- Abstracts are selected based on scientific merit, timeliness, and anticipated interest.
- The deadline to submit a late breaking abstract is April 22, 2024, by 11:59 PM PDT.

Abstract submissions should be as informative as possible. State the background and specific objective of the study. Shortly describe the methods used.
