to support the travel related expenses to this work. Two scholarships may be awarded each year. Applications will be accepted through March 19, 2024. Any member


planning to work, study, and/or research in an LMIC should apply for this scholarship.


#### The ANA Celebrates Women's History Month

We honor the incredible women pioneers of medicine and the remarkable women making a difference in the world of neurology and neuroscience today. As well, we honor the memory of those who blazed trails in neurology. Today, we honor the memory of <a href="Dorothy Klenke Nash">Dorothy Klenke Nash</a>, <a href="MD">MD</a>, who became the first female neurosurgeon in the Unites States. She received her medical degree from the Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons in 1927 and then trained at the Neurologic Institute of New York under Dr. Byron Stookey. During her training, Dr. Nash contributed to the advancement of neurosurgical practice through academic research. Remarkably, Dr. Nash maintained her status as the only female neurosurgeon in the US until 1960.
