



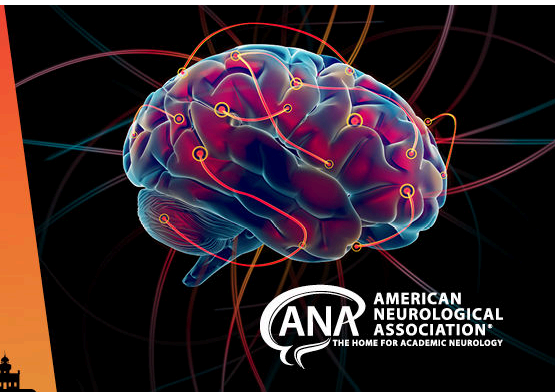
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

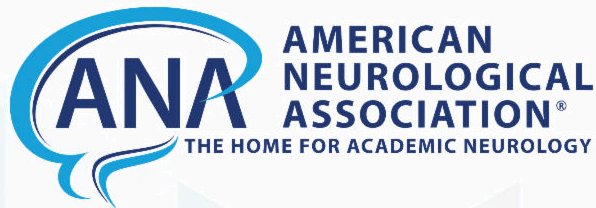
